## Creating an In-Ground Pool - Atlanta, GA

### Background Information

There is a growing trend to use above ground pools, in-ground! This is a huge savings. Above ground pools often get a bad rep for being an eye sore, but if you are strategic about your pool deck design, not only can you make your above ground pool look attractive, but you can also give it an "in-ground" effect. While above ground pools can look tacky, they can look just as nice as an in-ground pool when attention to certain details are applied.

Above ground pools are less expensive, easier to maintain, and in many cases don't increase your property tax. And by recessing one into the ground, you get the look and feel of an in-ground pool for a lot less money.

### Project Details

Once an above ground pool is installed in-ground, fill the pool and then backfill it with Low-Density Cellular Concrete (LDCC) or Permeable Low-Density Cellular Concrete (PLDCC) if you plan on using a Pervious Paver around your new pool.
